RESERVATIONS

Because we need to seat people 6 feet from each other, space will be very limited and it will be necessary for parishioners to reserve a place for the Mass they would like to attend.

To reserve a space at any of the Masses, contact the Parish Office ([781-862-0335](tel:781-862-0335)).

Please leave a message including your phone number, the number of people in your party (who live with you!) and the Mass that you would like to attend.

Your reservation WILL NOT be confirmed until a staff member confirms this when you call, or returns your call if you have left a message. We do not want to turn people away at the door so a reservation is needed each week.

Reservations can be made for the upcoming weekend beginning from Mondays at 9:00 am – Thursdays at 1:00 pm.

WHAT TO BRING TO MASS

Please bring (and wear) a facemask and also your own hand sanitizer.

ARRIVING FOR MASS AT SACRED HEART

The Church will open 15 minutes before Mass begins. Please practice safe-distancing, enter the church from Follen Street and follow the instructions of the ushers. Handicapped persons may enter at the handicap entrance. Holy Communion will be distributed from the center aisle beginning with the front rows. Please approach the minister with hands held together to form a cup into which the minister will drop the host in a no-touch manner. Immediately after receiving Communion, please exit by the side door and go directly to your car or home.

ARRIVING FOR MASS AT ST. BRIGID

The church will be open 15 minutes before the Mass begins. Please practice safe-distancing, enter through the center Mass Avenue doors, and follow the instructions of the ushers. Handicapped persons may enter at the handicap entrance. Holy Communion will be distributed from the side aisles beginning with the front rows. Immediately after receiving Communion, please exit by any of the doors and go directly to your car or home.

YOUR EXPERIENCE AT MASS

Our Masses will now be quite different from our usual celebrations. Each parishioner will need to wear a mask and we are not able to have singing or processions (entrance or offertory). After you are seated by the usher, remain there throughout the service. Holy Communion will be distributed at the end of Mass. Please approach the minister with hands held together making a cup so the minister can safely drop the host into your hands in a no-touch manner. Since there will be no offertory procession or collection, kindly make good use of the collection baskets at the doors of the church as you leave!

CAUTIONS

One bathroom will be open in each church for emergencies only. Keep in mind that mass will be less than 45 minutes, at the most.
